Guam Consumer Price Index (2nd Quarter 2011); Business and Economic Statistics Program, Bureau of Statistics and Plans; Quarterly. Several tables present current information and historical comparisons of the consumer price index.

Guam Export Report (March 2011); Business and Economic Statistics Program, Bureau of Statistics and Plans; Quarterly. This pamphlet presents the value of Guam's exported goods (including transhipped goods) by commodity group.

Guam Import Data (March Calendar Year 2011); Business and Economic Statistics Program, Bureau of Statistics and Plans; Quarterly. This pamphlet presents the value of Guam's imported goods (including transhipped goods) by commodity group

Unemployment Situation on Guam (March 2011); Bureau of Labor Statistics, Department of Labor; Periodically. Contains statistics on the civilian labor force by selected categories including unemployment rates by age, sex, household heads, full-time/part-time, U.S. citizens, immigrant aliens, veterans, not in the labor force, and average duration of unemployment. This information is based on the Current Labor Force Survey (CLFS) of households on Guam.

ECONOMICS

State of the Island Address (2011); Governor of Guam; Annually. A report on the state of the Territory by the Governor which addresses issues on Guam including economic, demographic, political, environmental, etc.

The Executive Budget for the Territory of Guam (FY2011); Bureau of Budget and Management Research; Annually. This report reflects the planned expenditures of the Executive Branch for the fiscal year. The Executive Budget contains financial statements, revenue statement, resource requirements and program description, capital improvement projects request, and the federal programs inventory. In addition, this document represents the Bureau of Budget and Research Management's annual report.

Federal Transactions for Work Performed in Guam, Update and Addendum; Guam Economic Development Authority with technical assistance from the Bureau of Statistics and Plans; January 2011. This report updates the September 2009 "Federal Transactions for Work Performed in Guam" and addresses the extent to which Guam businesses participate in federal contracting with the objective of ensuring that local businesses obtain as much as possible to participate in federal contracting. The report provides information on off-island and large and small Guam business participation, number of transactions, obligation and de-obligation amounts to contractors by the federal government, and products and services for work performed in Guam to meet federal demand.

Grants to the Outer Pacific: 2010; Federal Regional Council, Outer Pacific Committee, Region IX; March 2011. Annual report that lists grants awarded to Guam, American Samoa, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, the Freely Associated States of the Federated States of Micronesia, the

Republic of the Marshall Islands, and the Republic of Palau. The report includes information about the federal granting agency, its programs, and amount awarded to each of the areas.

Guam Hotel and Restaurant Association Summary Statistical Report (April 2011); Guam Hotel and Restaurant Association; Monthly. Presents summary statistics on hotel rooms, room rates, occupancy rates and taxes, and room-employee ratio.

EDUCATION

Guam Community College Fact Book, Volume IV (Academic Year 2009 - 2010); Guam Community College. Presents a comprehensive profile of Guam Community College with the types of programs of study available and other campus information. Includes fall term enrollment data for 2009 to 2010.

ENVIRONMENT

International Coastal Cleanup, Results (2010); Ocean Conservancy; Annually. Highlights coastal cleanup activities in the United States and territories. Presents results of marine and plastic debris collected, commercial fishing wastes, sewage-associated wastes, and volunteer participation by state and territory. Includes Guam.

Guam Transportation Stormwater Drainage Manual; Parson Transportation group Inc., for the Department of Public Works; August 2010. This manual provides guidelines for the planning and design of stormwater management facilities for transportation projects on the island of Guam. Transportation projects include any new development, redevelopment, reconstruction, rehabilitation or restoration of highways, roadways, and parkings. Including the appurtenant structures such as bridges and culverts. Conformance to the provisions of this

manual will result in consistent design procedures and should support acceptance of stormwater planning by regulatory agencies. The design criteria established supersedes other previously-published stormwater drainage manuals and guidelines used by Department of Public Works. This manual will be updated regularly to reflect changes in regulations and advances in stormwater management technology, and to clarify issues.

GEOLOGY

Annual Water Quality Report (2010); Guam Waterworks Authority; Annually. An annual evaluation of Guam's water quality to ensure the safety of the islands' drinking water. This leaflet summarizes the results of water quality tests that were conducted on Guam's drinking water from January to December. It provides information on source of drinking water and identifies contaminants present in the water.

HISTORY

Families Under Siege; Guam Humanities Council; Not dated. This two compact-disc documentary takes a look at Guam during the Japanese occupation of World War II. While no one denies reports of cruel treatment by the foreign soldiers between late 1941 and the summer of 1944, there are also compassionate stories that Chamorros tell. Some of these stories of the war tell of friendships that formed between Chamorros and Japanese and of the gratitude felt by both parties.

LAND

Procedures Guide for Achieving Federal Consistency with the Guam Coastal Management Program (Revised Edition); Funded by a grant from the U.S. Department of Commerce, National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) through the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 as amended, administered by the Office of Ocean and Coastal Resource Management Program (OCRM) and the Guam Coastal Management Program (GCMP) of the Bureau of Statistics and Plans (BSP), Government of Guam through Grant Number NA08NOS4190455; May 2011. A guideline to procedures for federal consistency review to guide the use,

protection and development of land and ocean resources within Guam's coastal zone. The guide is designed to assist agencies and individuals to determine whether their proposed actions are subject to federal consistency review.

POPULATION

Yearbook of the Immigration Statistics (2009); Office of Immigration Statistics, U.S. Department of Homeland Security; Annually. Provides immigration data along with related historical information. The major areas covered includes legal permanent residents; refugees and asylees approved; naturalizations; nonimmigrant admissions; aliens apprehended and expelled; and aliens inspected at ports of entry. Includes Guam.

Guam Chamber of Commerce Membership Directory (2011); Guam Chamber of Commerce. This directory lists its members and associate members of the Guam Chamber of Commerce by type of business and industry.

Guam Hotel and Restaurant Association Directory (2011); Guam Hotel and Restaurant Association; Annually. Presents a brief history and mission statement of the Guam Hotel and Restaurant Association. Includes a list of active members and associate members.

SAFETY

Judiciary of Guam Annual Report (2010); Unified Judiciary of Guam, Superior Court of Guam and Supreme Court of Guam; Annually. Covers information on the functions of the various divisions of the court and presents statistical data on areas of concern to each division. This report also contains the annual caseload report and analysis by month for criminal (felony), criminal (misdemeanor), civil division, juvenile delinquent division, small claims division, special proceedings division, probate division, and land registration division. Annual reports from other years follow similar formats and contain many interesting tables and graphs descriptive of the

Court's operations for their respective years.

Uniform Crime Report (2009); Guam Police Department; Annually. A standard statistical report in table and graph format showing the current year's data with comparison to the other years. Includes a history of the Guam Police Department. Formerly known as the Annual Crime Report.

Unified Judiciary of Guam Strategic Plan: 2007 - 2010; Unified Judiciary of Guam; 2007-2010. The strategic plan contains priorities, goals and objectives that the courts will work toward achieving for the next three years. The report addresses fundamental issues facing the judiciary of Guam including trend analysis, organizational assessment, opportunities, and potential threats and obstacles. Strategic issues discussed include access to courts and delivery of court services, operational efficiency and effectiveness, satisfied and skilled workforce, partnerships and community relations.

SOCIAL

Guam 2012-2015 Four Year State Plan on Aging, Draft; Division of Senior Citizens, Department of Public Health and Social Services; April 2011. Program plan that addresses the needs of Guam's aging population for the period 2012 to 2015. It outlines long-term care initiatives and objectives aimed at helping Guam's aging community including improving their nutrition, mental and physical well being. It describes the different programs and services offered under the Division of Senior Citizens, Department of Public Health and Social Services and collaborative work with local health service partners.

Developmental Disabilities Five Year State Plan, Developmental Disabilities Basic State Grant Program Development Disabilities Assistance and Bill of Rights Act of 2000, Part B (Public Law 106-402) (Fiscal Years 2007-2011); Guam Developmental Disabilities Council. Reviews the existing service delivery system and outlines a plan to provide services to persons with developmental disabilities and their families.
